Background

The [IMI-funded PARADIGM](#) project aims to make patient engagement in medicines development easier for all. This public private partnership, strong of 34 partners started its work in early 2018 and will end in November 2020. The four patient organisations, members of the consortium ([European Patients' Forum](#), [EURORDIS-Rare Diseases Europe](#), [European AIDS Treatment Group](#) and [Alzheimer Europe](#)) jointly organise four sessions for their members in order to share the outcomes of the PARADIGM project fostering the use of the Patient Engagement Toolbox ([PE Toolbox](#)) and the tools developed by the PARADIGM project (*with the patients and their representatives as main target audience*).

Structure of the sessions
